Borders can make or break the finish of the quilt

Cutting lengthwise to prevent piecing (may need to purchase additional yardage)

Cutting the width of fabric and piecing on the 45° angle

Measure <u>your</u> quilt top in at least 3 places at the width and the length, average those numbers to know the size to cut the border. <u>Do Not</u> cut the borders until your quilt top is complete

To add all borders, follow this process:

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First measure (3 places and average) the border (length or width) you want to add Cut the border fabric Pin (ends and center then center out between the established pins) Stitch the 2 borders onto the quilt Press the seams, usually toward the border fabric Repeat the process to add the final 2 borders
